Objection

LPH Exhibit 47: Grain Belt Express objects to the admission of LPH 47 offered into evidence at the local public hearing in Cameron, Missouri on December 13, 2016 by Katie McKay. LPH Exhibit 47 is a data request response from Grain Belt Express to Missouri Landowners Alliance ("MLA") marked as "EA-2016-0358.GBX response to MLA-G52.Attachment 01". The responsive document itself is a Clinton County Missouri, County Apportionment Schedule 13, State Tax Commission of Missouri. The witness that offered the data response into evidence, Katie McKay, is an incorporator of Block Grain Belt Express Missouri, as shown in the attached Articles of Incorporation for Block Grain Belt Express Missouri, filed with the Missouri Secretary of State on February 10, 2014. See Exhibit 1.

It is entirely inappropriate for MLA to provide a representative of Block Grain Belt Express Missouri with a data request response from Grain Belt Express and attempt to have that

response entered into the evidentiary record via a witness at the local public hearing. While Grain Belt Express takes no issue with the document itself, MLA's attempt to circumvent the evidentiary hearing by having a proxy organization, Block Grain Belt Express Missouri, represented by the same legal counsel as MLA and coordinating with MLA¹, offer data request responses into the evidentiary record is a flagrant disregard for the purpose of the local public hearings and the ground rules established by the Commission for the local public hearings.
