COMES NOW Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri (Ameren Missouri or the Company), and pursuant to 4 CSR 240-20.093(8) and 4 CSR 240-3.163(5), files it's Demand-Side Program Annual Report for 2014 and states as follows:

1. Missouri Public Service Commission's (Commission) Missouri Energy Efficiency Investment Act (MEEIA) regulations require utilities with one or more approved demand-side programs to file a Demand-Side Program Annual Report no later than 60 days after the end of each calendar year.

2. Exhibit 1 to this pleading is Ameren Missouri's Demand-Side Program Annual Report for its 2014 MEEIA programs (an Excel Workbook having multiple tabs).
