- 5. No later than May 29, 2011, the Office of the Public Counsel, and any other interested person or entity, may file comments regarding The Empire District Electric Company's Annual Renewable Energy Standard Compliance Plan.

¹ Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-20.100 requires a 45-day response period following the filing of the plan. This deadline falls on Saturday, May 26, 2012. Monday, May 28, 2012 is the Memorial Day Holiday. Consequently, Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.050 operates to establish the deadline as the end of the next day which is not a Saturday, Sunday or legal holiday, i.e. Tuesday, May 29, 2012.
