Please provide the following information:

- a. Is AmerenUE or Mr. Moehn aware of any request by the Company for any such "assurance"?
- b. Is AmerenUE or Mr. Moehn aware of any Missouri PSC Order or other document denying recovery of any "detrimental financial effects" that may have occurred at the Joppa Plant?
- c. Please provide complete copies of all testimony, pleadings, correspondence, MPSC Orders and other documents (if any) that were relied upon by Mr. Moehn to determine that shareholders were at risk for any events or detrimental financial effects that may arise at the Joppa Plant.

## Response:

AmerenUE has always treated the investment in EEInc. as a below-the-line investment. It has never behaved inconsistently with that treatment. Accordingly, it has never asked, nor would it ask, the Missouri Public Service Commission for assurances that the Commission would act inconsistently with the below-the-line character of the investment EEInc. by recovering the costs of "detrimental financial effects" at EEInc. through rates.
