STATUS REPORT

COME NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, by and through the Staff Counsel's Office, The Empire District Electric Company ("Empire Electric"), The Empire District Gas Company ("Empire Gas"), Liberty Utilities (Midstates Natural Gas) Corp. ("Liberty Midstates"), and Liberty Utilities (Missouri Water) LLC ("Liberty Utilities") (collectively, "Applicants"), and Midwest Energy Consumers Group ("MECG") (collectively, "Signatories"), and hereby file their *Status Report* pursuant to the Commission's July 1, 2021, *Order Directing Filing of Status Report*. In support thereof, the Signatories state as follows:

1. The Signatories report that no further progress in the Applicants' CAM proceedings has occurred since the Commission's July 1st *Order*. However, while progress has not occurred in AW-2018-0394,¹ the Signatories continue to agree that future progress in this CAM proceeding is dependent upon the promulgation of new Affiliate Transaction Rules ("ATRs"); which will likely contain differences from the current electric, gas, and heating ATRs, on which CAMs can then be based (and upon which any need for variances will need to be assessed). Therefore, the Signatories recommend the

Commission continue its stay of this case. The Signatories recognize that the ATRs continue to be in place and apply to the transactions of Empire Electric, Empire Gas, and Liberty Midstates.

2. Empire Electric's general rate case, Case No. ER-2021-0312, in which Staff, as part of its review, will conduct an audit of the various types of affiliate transactions Empire Electric engages in and provide testimony to the Commission supporting its findings pursuant to the Commission's *Report and Order* in Empire Electric's last rate case, Case No. ER-2019-0374, is ongoing.²

WHEREFORE Staff, the Applicants, and MECG pray the Commission will accept their December 30, 2021, *Status Report*.
