## ORDER GRANTING MOTION AND ESTABLISHING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On June 30, 2006 Ozark Energy Partners, LLC filed an application as described in the above caption. On July 5, the Missouri Public Service Commission issued an order directing the Staff of the Commission to file its memorandum in this matter no later than September 5, 2006. On August 11, Staff filed a motion to modify the Commission's order.

In its motion, Staff pointed out that Ozark's application does not include necessary information that will enable Staff to make an informed recommendation to the Commission. Staff therefore requested that the Commission modify its order to relieve Staff of having to file its memorandum on September 5. Rather, Staff suggested that the Commission set this matter for a prehearing conference to afford the parties an opportunity to explore a resolution of this case. The Commission granted Staff's motion and on September 14, Ozark filed a motion to set this matter for a prehearing conference to be held on October 19, 2006. Ozark states that the parties agree with that date.

The Commission has review Ozark's motion and, finding it reasonable, will grant the requested relief.

## IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. Ozark Energy Partners, LLC's motion to set this matter for a prehearing conference to be held on October 19, 2006 granted.
- 2. A prehearing conference shall be held on October 19, 2006, beginning at 10:00 a.m. in Room 305 of the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. This hearing will be held in a building that meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act.
