On December 6, 2006, Southern Missouri Gas Company, L.P., d/b/a Southern Missouri Natural Gas (SMNG), applied to the Commission for a certificate of service authority to provide natural gas service in the City of Lebanon, Missouri, and various unincorporated areas in Laclede and Webster Counties. The Commission gave notice of the application to interested entities and set a date for its Staff to file a recommendation or status report.

On February 27, 2007, Staff filed its response. Staff relates that it has submitted requests to SMNG for detailed information necessary to an analysis of the feasibility of the proposed project. Staff states that it is still investigating the matter and is not yet in a position to make an informed recommendation. Staff requests an extension of time and proposes to file another status report, or its final report, on or before April 15, 2007.

The Commission has considered the Staff's response and finds it reasonable to grant the requested extension.
