
## NOTICE REGARDING COMMUNICATION

On March 8, 2013, I spoke to Luann Ridgeway, Clay County Commissioner, who informed me of a public meeting that occurred on March 7, 2013, regarding Ameren providing service to an industrial customer(s) and installing infrastructure along a rural community boundary. Commissioner Ridgeway, in explaining the situation, mentioned a couple of options that she saw as an alternative to Ameren's current plan, which included building along an already existing easement close to a railroad and purchasing power from KCP&L.

I provided Commissioner Ridgeway with general information on the Commission's procedures including tariffs, informal complaints and formal complaints, and directed her to Chapter 386 and 4 CSR 240 to gain more information on the Commission's procedures.
