ORDER SETTING DEADLINE TO OBJECT TO
LATE-FILED APPLICATIONS TO INTERVENE

On July 10, 2006, Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE submitted to the Missouri Public Service Commission certain proposed tariff sheets, Tariff File No. YE-2007-0007. The purpose of the filing, according to AmerenUE, is to implement a general rate increase for retail electric service to customers in its Missouri service area.

The Commission issued notice of that filing on July 11, and established July 31 as the deadline for submission of requests to intervene. On August 18, 2006, the Missouri Department of Economic Development (DED) filed a late application to intervene. On August 21, 2006, the Commercial Group¹ filed an application for leave to intervene out of time.

Any party wishing to object to DED's or the Commercial Group's application for intervention must do so on or before August 25, 2006.

¹ The Commercial Group includes: JC Penney Corporation, Inc., Lowe's Home Centers, Inc., and Wal-Mart Stores East, LP.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Any party wishing to object to the Missouri Department of Economic Development's Late Filed Application to Intervene must do so on or before August 25, 2006.
2. Any party wishing to object to the Commercial Group's Application for Leave to Intervene Out of Time must do so on or before August 25, 2006.
3. This order shall become effective on August 22, 2006.
