On September 12, 2006, the Missouri Public Service Commission issued an order establishing December 15, 2006, at 5:00 p.m. as the deadline for filing revenue requirement direct testimony in this case. On December 19, 2006, the Office of the Public Counsel filed a Motion to Late File Testimony. In that motion, Public Counsel requested that the Commission accept the Direct Testimony of Public Counsel witness Ryan Kind which was filed just after the 5:00 p.m. deadline on the 15<sup>th</sup> due to computer problems. In further support of its motion Public Counsel states that neither any party nor the Commission would be harmed by accepting Mr. Ryan's testimony as filed, because it was only filed a few minutes after the deadline.
