On June 19, 2007, Mariza Davis filed a complaint with the Missouri Public Service Commission against Laclede Gas Company (Laclede). Laclede filed its answer to the complaint on July 20, 2007, and the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed its Report on August 15, 2007.

On September 7, 2007, a prehearing conference was held in this case. Parties participating in the prehearing included Laclede, the Commission's Staff, and the Office of the Public Counsel. Ms. Davis did not participate in the prehearing conference.

On September 14, 2007, Staff filed a motion requesting an additional twenty days to file a proposed procedural schedule in this case. The procedural schedule is currently due on September 14th. In support of its request, Staff states that it would like to give Laclede and Ms. Davis an opportunity to discuss possible resolutions before setting a procedural

schedule in this case. Staff further states that Laclede supports the request. The request for extension of time is reasonable and shall be granted.
