ORDER DIRECTING FILING

On February 1, 2006, Kansas City Power & Light Company submitted to the Commission proposed tariff sheets intended to implement a general rate increase for electrical service provided in its Missouri service area. On February 3, the Commission ordered that anyone who wished to intervene in this case do so no later than February 23.

On August 1, W. Bill Dias, d/b/a 1.PayStation.com, asked to intervene out of time. KCP&L objects to this application. The Commission will order Mr. Dias to supplement his application as follows:

- List the names of any witnesses you plan to call at the hearing;
- List the expertise of those witnesses;
- List the witnesses you wish to cross-examine, and the reasons you plan to cross-examine them;
- List the reasons the Office of the Public Counsel cannot adequately represent your interests;
- List the reasons that the testimony at the August 24, 2006 local public hearing will not suffice to give you your opportunity to be heard.

In addition, the Commission will remind Mr. Dias that if allowed to intervene, he may only represent himself, and not the interests of any other people or groups of people. Any attempt to express the views of anyone else is the unauthorized practice of law, and will not be tolerated.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Mr. Dias shall file a pleading as described above no later than August 21, 2006.
2. This order shall become effective on August 17, 2006.
