**ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO CLARIFY REVISED TRUE-UP**  
**RECONCILIATION**

On April 19, 2007, the Commission's Staff filed a revised true-up reconciliation. In its deliberations, the Commission has noticed that MIEC includes a \$30 million adjustment for Production Non-Nuclear Terminal Salvage. The briefs, which were filed after the reconciliation, indicate that AmerenUE now accepts Staff's position that terminal net salvage will not be allowed. The Commission wants to know whether MIEC's \$30 million adjustment for terminal salvage has already been removed from the company's revenue requirement indicated in the reconciliation.

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. The Staff of the Commission shall file a clarification of the revised true-up reconciliation no later than 9:00 a.m. on May 17, 2007.

2. This order shall become effective on May 15, 2007.
