To loan and otherwise advance funds from time to time, secured or unsecured for such purposes and upon such terms and conditions as the board of directors may determine;

To engage in the purchase and sale of real estate and communications;

And have and to exercise all powers necessary or incident to the carrying out of corporate purposes of a "FOR-PROFIT CORPORATION" organized under the laws of the State of Missouri, to enjoy all rights and powers which now or at any future time may be granted to or exercised by the Missouri charter for all general business purposes.
