APPLICATION FOR CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE BASIC LOCAL EXCHANGE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICE AND FOR COMPETITIVE CLASSIFICATION

4 CSR 240-2.060

Comes now Globetel, Inc., by its undersigned representative, and hereby applies pursuant to Sections 392.361, 392.420, and 392.430 RSMo 1994, 392.410, 392.450 RSMo Supp. 1996, the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996, and 4 CSR 240-2.060, for authority to provide basic local telecommunications service in portions of the State of Missouri and to classify said service and company as competitive. In support of its application Globetel, Inc. states as follows:

- 1. Applicant <u>Globetel, Inc.</u> is a corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of <u>Nevada</u>. Please see Exhibit A for a copy of the company's Articles of Incorporation, and Authority to do Business in Missouri.

- 3. <u>Globetel, Inc.</u> proposes to provide basic local exchange telecommunications service on a facilities basis, throughout all exchanges currently served by the incumbent local exchange telecommunications company(ies) of SBC. The specific SBC exchanges within which <u>Globetel, Inc.</u> proposes to offer service are listed in the incumbent providers respective local exchange tariffs. <u>Globetel, Inc.</u> may seek authority to provide this service in other areas of the state in a subsequent proceeding.
- 4. Pursuant to this application <u>Globetel</u>, <u>Inc.</u> seeks to offer and provide all forms of basic local telecommunications service to business class customers, including: <u>Digital PBX and Point to Point Access Loops</u>.
- 5. <u>Globetel, Inc.</u> possesses the technical and managerial expertise and experience necessary to provide the services it proposes. For technical expertise outside of the scope of Globetel, Inc.'s experience, Globetel, Inc. has contracted with a Consulting firm, AmericanCLEC. Description of backgrounds of <u>Globetel, Inc.</u> management, which demonstrate the extensive experience and expertise, along with a copy of the contract between Globetel, Inc. and AmerianCLEC are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit B. <u>Globetel, Inc.'s parent company, Quebec Inc. will provide full financial support to Globetel, Inc. until such time that Globetel, Inc. can sustain itself.</u> Quebec, Inc. possesses the necessary financial resources. A copy of supporting financial documents of Quebec, Inc., Globetel, Inc.'s financial supporter are attached as Exhibit C.
- 6. <u>Globetel, Inc.</u> seeks classification of itself and its services as competitive.
- 7. <u>Globetel, Inc.</u> will offer basic local telecommunications service as a separate and distinct service in accordance with applicable law. <u>Globetel, Inc.</u> will give consideration to equitable access for all Missourians, regardless of where they might reside or their income, to affordable telecommunications services in <u>Globetel, Inc.'s</u> proposed service areas in accordance with applicable law.
- 8. <u>Globetel, Inc.</u> is willing to comply with all applicable Commission rules and is willing to meet all relevant service standards, including, but not limited to billing, quality of service, and tariff filing and maintenance in a manner consistent

with the Commission's requirements for incumbent local exchange carrier(s) with whom <u>Globetel</u>, <u>Inc.</u> seeks authority to compete.

Additionally, Globetel, Inc. agrees that, pursuant to Section 392.455(3) & (4) RSMo Cum Supp. 1996, its service area shall be no smaller than a exchange and Globetel, Inc. will offer basic local telecommunications service as a separate and distinct service. Consistent with the Commission's treatment of other certificated competitive local exchange telecommunications companies, Globetel, Inc. requests the following statutes and regulations be waived for Globetel, Inc. and its basic local exchange service offerings:

- 9. It will promptly file said tariffs bearing no less than 45 day effective date with the Commission in a manner consistent with the Commission's practice in similar cases. In any circumstance, Applicant will file its proposed basic local exchange telecommunications service tariff no later than 30 days after Commission approval of Applicant's interconnection and/or resale agreement.
- 10. <u>Globetel, Inc.</u> submits that the public interest will be served by Commission approval of this application because <u>Globetel, Inc.'s</u> proposed services will create and enhance competition and expand customer service options consistent with the legislative goals set forth in the federal Telecommunications Act of 1996 and Chapter 392 RSMo. Prompt approval of this application also will expand the availability of innovative, high quality, and reliable telecommunications services within the State of Missouri.
- 11. Globetel, Inc. submits, notwithstanding the provisions of Section 392.500 RSMo., as a condition of certification and competitive classification, Globetel, Inc. agrees that, unless otherwise ordered by the Commission, Globetel, Inc. originating and terminating switched exchange access rates will be no greater than the lowest Commission-approved corresponding access rates in effect for each ILEC within those service area(s) Globetel, Inc. seeks authority to provide service. Additionally, pursuant to the Commission's Report and Order in Case No. TO-99-596 Globetel, Inc. agrees that if the ILEC in whose service area Globetel, Inc. is operating decreases its originating and/or terminating access service rates, Globetel, Inc. shall file an appropriate tariff

amendment to reduce its originating and/or terminating access rates within thirty (30) days of the ILEC's

reduction of its originating and/or terminating access rates in order to maintain the cap on switched exchange access rates. WHEREFORE, Applicant Globetel, Inc. respectfully requests that the Commission grant it a certificate of service authority to provide basic local telecommunications services as herein requested, classify Globetel, Inc. and its proposed services as competitive, and grant a waiver of the aforesaid statutes and regulations.
