APPLICATION FOR CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE BASIC LOCAL AND LOCAL EXCHANGE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICE AND FOR COMPETITIVE CLASSIFICATION

Comes now Globetel, Inc., by its undersigned attorneys, and hereby applies pursuant to Sections 392.361, 392.410, 392.420, 392.430, and 392.450, RSMo, the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996, and 4 CSR 240-2.060, for authority to provide basic local and local exchange telecommunications service in portions of the State of Missouri, to classify said service and company as competitive, and for approval of its initial tariff.

- 1. Applicant Globetel, Inc. ("Globetel") is a corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Nevada. Please see Exhibit A for a copy of the company's Articles of Incorporation, and Authority to do Business in Missouri.
- 2. All inquiries, correspondence, communications, pleadings, notices, orders and decisions relating to the case should be addressed to:

- 3. Globetel proposes to provide basic local and local exchange telecommunications service on a facilities basis, throughout all exchanges currently served by AT&T in Missouri. The specific exchanges within which Globetel proposes to offer service are listed in the AT&T local exchange tariffs. Globetel may seek authority to provide this service in other areas of the state in a subsequent proceeding.
- 4. Pursuant to this application Globetel seeks to offer and provide all forms of basic local and local exchange telecommunications service to business class customers, including Digital PBX and Point to Point Access Loops.
- 5. Globetel possesses the technical and managerial expertise and experience necessary to provide the services it proposes. For technical expertise beyond its current experience, Globetel has contracted with a consulting firm, AmericanCLEC. Descriptions of the backgrounds of Globetel

management, which demonstrate their extensive experience and expertise, is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit B. Globetel's parent company, Quebec Inc., will provide full financial support to Globetel until such time that Globetel can sustain itself. Quebec, Inc. possesses the necessary financial resources. A copy of supporting financial documents of Quebec, Inc., are attached as Exhibit C.

- 6. Globetel seeks classification of itself and its services as competitive. All of the services which Globetel proposes to provide are subject to sufficient competition that traditional regulation is unnecessary to protect the interests of Missouri consumers, and thus should be classified as competitive pursuant to Ch. 392.361.4, RSMo. Further, as all of Globetel's services are competitive, the company should be classified as a competitive telecommunications company by the Commission, pursuant to Ch. 392.361.3, RSMo.
- 7. Globetel will offer basic local telecommunications service as a separate and distinct service in accordance with Ch. 392.455.4, RSMo. Globetel will give consideration to equitable access for all Missourians, regardless of where they might reside or their income, to affordable telecommunications services in Globetel's proposed service areas in accordance with applicable law.
- 8. Globetel will comply with all applicable Commission rules and will meet all relevant service standards, including, but not limited to billing, quality of service, and tariff filing and maintenance in a manner consistent with the Commission's requirements for incumbent local exchange carrier(s) with whom Globetel seeks authority to compete. Additionally, Globetel agrees that, pursuant

to Section 392.455.3 and .4, RSMo, its service area shall be no smaller than an exchange and it will offer basic local telecommunications service as a separate and distinct service.

9. Consistent with the Commission's treatment of other certificated competitive local exchange telecommunications companies, Globetel requests the following statutes and regulations be waived for Globetel and its basic local and local exchange service offerings:

- 10. Globetel files herewith a tariff bearing a 45-day effective date, and requests Commission approval of that tariff.
- 11. Globetel submits that the public interest will be served by Commission approval of this application because Globetel's proposed services will create and enhance competition and expand customer service options consistent with the

legislative goals set forth in the federal Telecommunications Act of 1996 and Chapter 392 RSMo. Prompt approval of this application also will expand the availability of innovative, high quality, and reliable telecommunications services within the State of Missouri.

- 12. Globetel agrees, notwithstanding the provisions of Section 392.500 RSMo., as a condition of certification and competitive classification, that, unless otherwise ordered by the Commission, its originating and terminating switched exchange access rates will be no greater than the lowest Commission-approved corresponding access rates in effect for each ILEC within those service area(s) Globetel seeks authority to provide service. Additionally, pursuant to the Commission's Report and Order in Case No. TO-99-596, Globetel agrees that if the ILEC in whose service area Globetel is operating decreases its originating and/or terminating access service rates, Globetel shall file an appropriate tariff amendment to reduce its originating and/or terminating access rates within thirty (30) days of the ILEC's reduction of its originating and/or terminating access rates in order to maintain the cap on switched exchange access rates.
- 13. Globetel submits that there is no pending action or final unsatisfied judgment or decision against it from any state or federal agency or court which involve customer service or rates.
- 14. Globetel submits that no annual report or assessment fees are overdue.

WHEREFORE, Applicant Globetel respectfully requests that the Commission grant it a certificate of service authority to provide basic local and

local exchange telecommunications services as herein requested, classify Globetel and its proposed services as competitive, and grant a waiver of the aforesaid statutes and regulations.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

FIRST. The name of the corporation is:

Globetel, Inc.

SECOND. Its registered office in the State of Nevada is located at 2533 North Carson Street, Carson City, Nevada 89706 that this Corporation may maintain an office, or offices in such other place within or without the State of Nevada as may be from time to time designated by the Board of Directors, or by the By-Laws of said Corporation, and that this Corporation may conduct all Corporation business of every kind and nature, including the holding of all meetings of Directors and Stockholders, outside the State of Nevada as well as within the State of Nevada

THIRD. The objects for which this Corporation is formed are: To engage in any lawful activity, including, but not limited to the following:

- (A) Shall have such rights, privileges and powers as may be conferred upon corporations by any existing law.
- (B) May at any time exercise such rights, privileges and powers, when not inconsistent with the purposes and objects for which this corporation is organized.
- (C) Shall have power to have succession by its corporate name for the period limited in its certificate or articles of incorporation, and when no period is limited, perpetually, or until dissolved and its affairs wound up according to law.
 - (D) Shall have power to sue and be sued in any court of law or equity.

- (E) Shall have power to make contracts.
- (F) Shall have power to hold, purchase and convey real and personal estate and to mortgage or lease any such real and personal estate with its franchises. The power to hold real and personal estate shall include the power to take the same by devise or bequest in the State of Nevada, or in any other state, territory or country.
- (G) Shall have power to appoint such officers and agents as the affairs of the corporation shall require, and to allow them suitable compensation.
- (H) Shall have power to make By-Laws not inconsistent with the constitution or laws of the United States, or of the State of Nevada, for the management, regulation and government of its affairs and property, the transfer of its stock, the transaction of its business, and the calling and holding of meetings of its stockholders.
 - (I) Shall have power to wind up and dissolve itself, or be wound up or dissolved.
- (J) Shall have power to adopt and use a common scal or stamp, and alter the same at pleasure. The use of a scal or stamp by the corporation on any corporate documents is not necessary. The corporation may use a scal or stamp, if it desires, but such use or nonuse shall not in any way affect the legality of the document.
- (K) Shall have power to borrow money and contract debts when necessary for the transaction of its business, or for the exercise of its corporate rights, privileges or franchises, or for any other lawful purpose of its incorporation; to issue bonds, promissory notes, bills of exchange, debentures, and other obligations and evidences of indebtedness, payable at a specified time or times, or payable upon the happening of a specified event or events,

whether secured by mortgage, pledge or otherwise, or unsecured, for money borrowed, or in payment for property purchased, or acquired, or for any other lawful object.

- (L) Shall have power to guarantee, purchase, hold, sell; assign, transfer, mortgage, pledge or otherwise dispose of the shares of the capital stock of, or any bonds, securities or evidences of the indebtedness created by, any other corporation or corporations of the State of Nevada, or any other state or government, and, while owners of such stock, bonds, securities or evidences of indebtedness, to exercise all the rights, powers and privileges of ownership, including the right to vote, if any.
- (M) Shall have power to purchase, hold, sell and transfer shares of its own capital stock, and use therefore its capital, capital surplus, surplus, or other property or fund.
- (N) Shall have power to conduct business, have one or more offices, and hold, purchase, mortgage and convey real and personal property in the State of Nevada, and in any of the several states, territories, possessions and dependencies of the United States, the District of Columbia, and any foreign countries.
- (O) Shall have power to do all and everything necessary and proper for the accomplishment of the objects enumerated in its certificate or articles of incorporation, or any amendment thereof, or necessary or incidental to the protection and benefit of the corporation, and, in general, to carry on any lawful business necessary or incidental to the attainment of the objects of the corporation, whether or not such business is similar in nature to the objects set forth in the certificate or articles of incorporation of the corporation, or any amendment thereof.

- (P) Shall have power to make donations for the public welfare or for charitable, scientific or educational purposes.
- (Q) Shall have power to enter into partnerships, general or limited, or joint ventures, in connection with any lawful activities, as may be allowed by law.

FOURTH. That the total number of common stock authorized that may be issued by the Corporation is SEVENTY FIVE THOUSAND (75,000) shares of stock without nominal par value and no other class of stock shall be authorized. Said shares may be issued by the corporation, from time to time, for such considerations as may be fixed by the Board of Directors.

<u>FIFTH.</u> The governing board of this corporation shall be known as directors, and the number of directors may from time to time be increased or decreased in such manner as shall be provided by the By-Laws of this Corporation, providing that the number of directors shall not be reduced to fewer than one (1):

<u>TENTH.</u> In furtherance and not in limitation of the powers conferred by statute, the Board of Directors is expressly authorized:

Subject to the By-Laws, if any, adopted by the Stockholders, to make, after or amend the By-Laws of the Corporation.

To fix the amount to be reserved as working capital over and above its capital stock paid in; to authorize and cause to be executed, mortgages and liens upon the real and personal property of this Corporation.

By resolution passed by a majority of the whole Board, to designate one (1) or more committees, each committee to consist of one or more of the Directors of the Corporation, which, to the extent provided in the resolution, or in the By-Laws of the Corporation, shall have and may exercise the powers of the Board of Directors in the management of the business and affairs of the Corporation. Such committees, or committees, shall have such name, or names, as may be stated in the By-Laws of the Corporation, or as may be determined from time to time by resolution adopted by the Board of Directors.

When and as authorized by the affirmative vote of the Stockholders holding stock entitling them to exercise at least a majority of the voting power given at a Stockholders meeting called for that purpose, or when authorized by the written consent of the holders of at least a majority of the voting stock issued and outstanding, the Board of Directors shall have power and authority at any meeting to sell, lease or exchange all of the property and assets of the Corporation, including its good will and its corporate franchises, upon such terms and conditions as its board of Directors deems expedient and for the best interests of the Corporation.

ELEVENTH. No shareholder shall be entitled as a matter of right to subscribe for or receive additional shares of any class of stock of the Corporation, whether now or hereafter authorized, or any bonds, debentures or securities convertible into stock, but such additional shares of stock or other securities convertible into stock may be issued or disposed of by the Board of Directors to such persons and on such terms as in its discretion it shall deem advisable.

Iwelfth. No director or officer of the Corporation shall be personally liable to the Corporation or any of its stockholders for damages for breach of fiduciary duty as a director or officer involving any act or omission of any such director or officer; provided, however, that the foregoing provision shall not eliminate or limit the liability of a director or officer (i) for acts or omissions which involve intentional misconduct, fraud or a knowing violation of law, or (ii) the payment of dividends in violation of Section 78.300 of the Nevada Revised Statutes. Any repeal or modification of this Article by the stockholders of the Corporation shall be prospective only, and shall not adversely affect any limitation on

the personal liability of a director or officer of the Corporation for acts or omissions prior to such repeal or modification.


