ORDER GRANTING STAFF'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE ISSUES LIST, WITNESS LIST, AND ORDER OF CROSS-EXAMINATION

On February 1, 2006, Kansas City Power & Light Company submitted to the Commission proposed tariff sheets intended to implement a general rate increase for electrical service provided in its Missouri service area. The Commission issued an Order Adopting Procedural Schedule on March 29, 2006, that, in part, required the parties to file a list of issues, witness list and order of cross-examination no later than September 29, 2006.

On September 29, 2006, the Staff of the Commission filed a Motion for Extension of Time to File Issues List, Witness List, and Order of Cross-Examination. In that motion, Staff explains that those items are not yet ready for filing, that an extension of time will not delay the remainder of the procedural schedule, and that while Staff had been unable to contact all of the parties before filing the motion, Staff did contact most of the parties, all of whom did not object to the motion. Staff asks the Commission to grant it until October 6 to file that pleading. The Commission has reviewed Staff's motion, finds it to be reasonable, and will grant it.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Staff's Motion for Extension of Time to File Issues List, Witness List,

and Order of Cross-Examination is granted.

2. The Staff of the Commission shall file an Issues List, Witness List, and

Order of Cross-Examination no later than October 6, 2006.

3. This order shall become effective on October 2, 2006.
