**ORDER CANCELING HEARING**

Effective Date: November 13, 2007

On July 3, 2007, Bobby J. Armour filed a complaint with the Missouri Public Service Commission against Laclede Gas Company. Laclede filed its answer to the complaint on August 9, 2007, and the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed its Report on August 16, 2007.

On August 24, 2007, the Commission directed Mr. Armour to file a response addressing the statements contained in Laclede Gas Company's answer and Staff's report. Mr. Armour filed that response on September 10, 2007. At the request of the parties, the Commission set this matter for evidentiary hearing on November 15, 2007.

On November 8, 2007, Laclede advised the assigned regulatory law judge that it believed a settlement had been reached with Mr. Armour and asked that the November 15<sup>th</sup> hearing be postponed to allow the parties to finalize their settlement and for Mr. Armour to dismiss his complaint. On November 13, 2007, the Commission's Staff advised the regulatory law judge that Mr. Armour also wished to postpone the pending hearing to allow

finalization of a settlement agreement. The Commission agrees with the parties that the currently scheduled hearing should be cancelled to allow the parties additional time to pursue settlement discussions.

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. The evidentiary hearing currently scheduled for November 15, 2007, is cancelled.
2. In the event the Complaint is not dismissed on or before December 13, 2007, Laclede Gas Company will file a status report on that date.
3. This order shall become effective on November 13, 2007.
