AGP RESPONSE TO ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

COMES NOW AG PROCESSING INC A COOPERATIVE ("AGP") and
in response to the August 13, 2015 Order to Show Cause in
this matter respectfully states:

1. AGP appreciates the patience of the Commission as
this matter has taken longer to conclude than was originally
anticipated.

2. A major part of the delay has been engendered by
the parties mutual desire to accommodate or address in the
settlement document the appropriate handling of changes in
environmental modifications that were made or planned to be made
at the Lake Road Plant. The passage of time has eliminated the
need to address these changes in the settlement document.

3. Delay was also caused by the mutual need consis-
tently to resolve compensation made necessary by the passage of
time. AGP understands that to have been resolved.

4. AGP now respectfully advises the Commission that execution by both parties of a final settlement agreement is imminent. The settlement agreement is intended to fully dispose of the complaints encompassed by this and the earlier case with which is was consolidated.

5. Accordingly, dismissal of this matter would be premature. Disposition of these matters is intended to be addressed in the final settlement document. That document is expected to be finalized and submitted to the Commission for its approval, if necessary, within a few days.

6. It is also expected that the Respondent KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company will concur in this filing with respect to the status of the settlement process and the status of final agreement.


