1 JUDGE WOODRUFF: This is Case 2 No. ER-2012-0166, which is Ameren Missouri's 3 tariffs to increase its revenues for electric service. 4 This is a prehearing conference, and we'll 5 begin by taking entries of appearance beginning with Ameren Missouri. 6 7 MR. BYRNE: Thank you, your Honor. Tom Byrne and Wendy Tatro appearing on behalf of Ameren 8 9 Missouri. Our address is 1901 Chouteau Avenue, St. Louis, Missouri 63103. 10 11 MR. LOWERY: Morning, your Honor. James Lowery, Smith Lewis, LLP, 111 South Ninth Street, 12 13 Suite 200, Columbia, Missouri 65201, appearing on 14 behalf of Ameren Missouri. JUDGE WOODRUFF: And for the Staff. 15 16 MR. THOMPSON: Thank you, Judge. Kevin 17 Thompson, Steve Dottheim, Sarah Kliethermes, Megan 18 McClowery, Amy Moore, for the Staff of the Public Service Commission, P.O. Box 360, Jefferson City, 19 20 Missouri 65102. JUDGE WOODRUFF: For Public Counsel. 21 MR. MILLS: On behalf of the Office of the 22 23 Public Counsel and the public, my name is Lewis Mills. My address is P.O. FRAZIER: Thank you. Jenny Frazier for the Department of Natural Resources. I'm with the 10 11 Attorney General's Office, P.O. Box 899, Jefferson 12 City 65102. 13 JUDGE WOODRUFF: And for KCP&L, KCP&L-GMO. 14 MR. DORITY: Larry Dority and James Fischer, Fischer & Dority, P.C. Our address is 15 16 101 Madison Street, Suite 400, Jefferson City, Missouri 65101, appearing on behalf of Interveners 17 18 Kansas City Power & Light Company and KCP&L Greater 19 Missouri Operations Company. 20 JUDGE WOODRUFF: The Sierra Club group. 1 JUDGE WOODRUFF: Anyone here for AARP or 2 Consumers Council? 3 (No response.) 4 JUDGE WOODRUFF: For Barnes Jewish 5 Hospital. 6 MS. LANGENECKERT: Good morning, Judge 7 Woodruff. Lisa Langeneckert appearing on behalf of 8 Barnes Jewish Hospital. I'm with the law firm of 9 Sandberg, Phoenix and von Gontard, 600 Washington Avenue, 15th Floor, St. Louis, Missouri 63101. 10 11 JUDGE WOODRUFF: For the Midwest Energy 12 Consumers. 13 MR. WOODSMALL: Morning, your Honor. 14 Appearing on behalf of the Midwest Energy Consumers, 15 David Woodsmall. 5 I did want to mention, also, that I will be doing a discovery order at some point in the case, 6 7 so if you have suggestions on how that'll work, and 8 then what I'm anticipating doing is monthly discovery 9 conferences -- apparently worked fairly well in the Missouri-American rate case -- to try and keep 10 11 discovery moving along and resolve any disputes that 12 arise as they arise.

13 If you have any suggestions on language
14 that you want to see, include it in that also.
15 Provide documents on that by the 31st.

16 I do have some people on the telephone.
17 Apparently, no attorneys. You might want to introduce
18 yourself and let me know who's there.

19Do we have some people on the telephone20line? Maybe I lost the telephone line. Excuse me.

21 MR. ROBERTSON: This is Henry Robertson on 22 the phone. I can't hear a thing.

JUDGE WOODRUFF: Okay. I'm not sure what the problem with the line is. Can you hear any better now? You're coming across very garbled here also.

Stay on the line. I'm going to hang up and try and 1 2 reset the line here. If anybody has any suggestions 3 on how to deal with the phone, let me know. (A discussion was held off the record.) 4 5 JUDGE WOODRUFF: We're back on the record now. We had some problems with the technology on the 6 7 phone-in lines. The parties who didn't answer before 8 couldn't hear me on the phone, so we'll go back and 9 take entries of appearance from them. For Sierra Club. 10 11 MR. ROBERTSON: Henry Robertson, Great Rivers Environmental Law Center, 705 Olive Street, 12 13 Suite 614, St. Louis 63101. 14 JUDGE WOODRUFF: For AARP and the Consumers 15 Council. 16 MR. COFFMAN: This is John Coffman. Address: 871 Tuxedo Boulevard, St. Louis, Missouri 17 18 63109. 19 JUDGE WOODRUFF: All right. And for MIEC. 20 MS. VUYLSTEKE: Diana Vuylsteke with Bryan Cave, 211 North Broadway, Suite 3200, St Louis 63102. 21 22 JUDGE WOODRUFF: All right. 23 And Wendy Tatro representing Ameren Missouri is also on the line, I believe. Is that 24 25 correct, Ms. Tatro?

1 MS. TATRO: Yes, I am. Thank you. 2 JUDGE WOODRUFF: Very good. 3 Well, I'm glad we were able to get everybody connected here. As I was saying 4 5 before, this is a prehearing conference. By 6 previous order I directed the parties to file 7 test year recommendations and recommendations 8 regarding local public hearings by a week from 9 today, March 13, and I also indicated we'll be 10 doing a discovery order similar to what was done in the recent Missouri-American case where we'll 11 12 have monthly discovery conferences so we can 13 keep things moving as far as any discovery 14 disputes that arise, and if you have any 15 suggestions on particular language you want to 16 see in the discovery order, you can give that to 17 me also by the 13th. 18 Anything anybody else wants to bring 19 up while we're on the record? 20 (No response.) JUDGE WOODRUFF: All right. Hearing 21 nothing, then, I'll leave you to your 22 23 discussions. Thank you all very much. 24 (The hearing concluded.) 25
