So August 20, if you can allow us at least two 2 agenda meetings before that following the final briefs 3 for the Commission to deliberate and for me to write an order if that becomes necessary. As you can see, it's 4 5 fairly tight time frames here. So I'll ask you to give me a procedural 6 7 schedule, file something tomorrow, and that will give a chance to the Commission to look to issue something at 8 9 next week's agenda. Anything we need to discuss while 10 we're still on the record? Looking around and seeing 11 all the head shaking.
