1 PROCEEDINGS 2 JUDGE JORDAN: And we're on the record. The commission calls the action in file number 3 4 ER-2016-0156. This relates to the pending tariffs proposing a rate increase for KCP&L Greater Missouri 5 6 Operations Company which I will refer to as GMO for 7 short. 8 My name is Daniel Jordan. I'm the 9 regulatory law judge assigned to this action. I preside over this and similar proceedings. My job 10 is to conduct an orderly procedure. I will 11 eventually draft an order which will go to the full 12 commission for a vote at an open meeting. Also, 13 with us tonight is commissioner Bill Kenney. 14 Commissioner? 15 16 COMMISSIONER KENNEY: Thank you, Judge, 17 I appreciate it. It's nice to see everybody here 18 tonight. Again, my name's Bill Kenney. I'm one of 19 five Public Service Commissioners. We are appointed 20 by the governor and confirmed by the Senate. We 21 have a court reporter here tonight so the other four 22 commissioners will get an opportunity to review your 23 transcripts and what's spoken here tonight, so I appreciate it. And I will give you a little note, 24 I've been a Lee's Summit resident since 1981 so 25

whatever decisions that we make affect me, also. 1 2 But thank you for being here. 3 JUDGE JORDAN: We'll go straight to entries of appearance for parties. We'll start with 4 the applicant. 5 6 MR. HACK: For Kansas City Power & 7 Light Greater Missouri Operations Company, Robert 8 Hack. I've provided my contact information earlier. 9 JUDGE JORDAN: Thank you. And for the 10 staff. MR. JOHNSON: On behalf of the staff of 11 Public Service Commission, Mark Johnson. I've 12 provided my contact information to the court 13 14 reporter. JUDGE JORDAN: Thank you. For the 15 16 Office of the Public Counsel. 17 MR. OWEN: Thank you, Judge. My name 18 is James Owen. And any 23 intervenors? 24 MS. FINDLEY: My name is Beth Findley and I'm here for Ameren Missouri. 25

1	JUDGE JORDAN: Thank you. Any other
2	intervenors with us this evening?
3	All right then. Let's talk about
4	testimony. The purpose of this local public hearing
5	is at least in this phase to hear your testimony.
6	That is sworn testimony, I'll administer an oath, or
7	affirmation if you prefer, just tell me, and the
8	court reporter will record what you say so that as
9	the commission referred to earlier the other
10	commissioners can review it when it's time for them
11	to make their decision.
12	If you want to testify, well, I've got
13	some names here on my signup sheet, I will call your
14	name, come on up to the podium, make sure you use
15	the mic, speak clearly, everybody wants to hear what
16	you have to say. I will get you started by asking
17	you a few questions to make sure we have the
18	spelling of your name right, your relationship with
19	the company GMO, things like that. Out of respect
20	for everyone's time do be concise. Say what you
21	want to say but try to be concise. And if you just
22	want to agree with something someone has said
23	earlier, tell us that's, that's all you have to say
24	is you agree with the previous speaker, but we do
25	want to hear that so please feel free to do that.

1	When you are done with your testimony	
2	hang on at the podium for a while because the	
3	parties may have a few questions, I may have a	
4	question, the Commissioner may have a question, just

1 So how many times do we have to pay for this 2 increase? We're paying for it multiple times just 3 because we happen to be a bottom-of-the-chain 4 consumer. That's all I have to say. JUDGE JORDAN: Well, thank you for 5 6 saying that. Questions from counsel? The Office of 7 Public Counsel. 8 MR. OWEN: Yes, thank you, Judge. 9 Ma'am, can you hear me all right? 10 MS. ROBBINS: Yes. 11 MR. OWEN: I wanted to ask you, can you tell me who your electric utility provider is? 12 MS. ROBBINS: KCP&L. 13 MR. OWEN: Have you ever heard of the 14 utility provider KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations? 15 16 MS. ROBBINS: No. 17 MR. OWEN: Okay. Thank you. 18 JUDGE JORDAN: Questions from any other 19 counsel? 20 COMMISSIONER KENNEY: Thank you very 21 much, ma'am. 22 JUDGE JORDAN: Thank you for your 23 testimony. The next name on my list is David Eller. Would David Eller like to come up and testify? Not 24 25 seeing Mr. Eller I'll go on to the next name. I

1 have Paul Campo. Is there a Paul Campo? MR. CAMPO: Your Honor, I'll forego my 2 3 testimony. 4 JUDGE JORDAN: Very good. Thank you 5 for coming by and listening. And the last name I 6 have looks like Levi Woodson is it, or Wilburn? 7 MR. WILBURN: I'll forego as well, Your 8 Honor. JUDGE JORDAN: Well, that's all the 9 10 names I have on my list, but while we're here is 11 there anyone else who feels like giving testimony? 12 Not seeing anyone. Closing remarks. COMMISSIONER KENNEY: Just this process 13 14 takes a total of 11 months, and just because the company makes a request does not mean that that's 15 16 what is the final outcome. We have several 17 intervenors like the Office of Public Counsel, 18 consumers' counsels, industrial groups, hospital 19 associations, and then we will have a hearing. I think we're scheduled for seven days beginning in 20 21 the middle of September. That is available to watch 22 on the internet, and then after that within a couple 23 months after that we get together and hash out the details. A lot of times the groups all get together 24 25 and present us as the Commission a stipulation and
