ORDER GRANTING STAFF'S MOTION TO REFILE COST OF SERVICE REPORT AND DIRECTING THE REMOVAL OF PREVIOUSLY FILED COST OF SERVICE REPORT FROM EFIS

On September 8, 2008, the Commission's Staff refiled its Revenue Requirement Cost of Service Report, which it had previously filed on August 28. Staff filed a motion along with its refilled report asking leave to refile. Staff explains that the refiling is necessary to protect certain information as highly confidential that was treated as public information in the original filing. Staff also asks the Commission to direct its Data Center to remove the original report from the Commission's electronic filing system.

On September 16, Noranda Aluminum filed a pleading that does not oppose Staff's motion, but expresses concern about the reclassification of Staff's document from public to highly confidential. Noranda points out that the reclassification of a document from public to highly confidential could cause problems for parties who relied on the initial public classification of the document to distribute it to persons who should not be given access to a highly confidential document. At least, the parties need to be given notice that the reclassification has occurred so that they can handle the reclassified document appropriately.

Noranda's suggestions are well taken and will be addressed. The Commission thanks Noranda for bringing this matter to its attention.

Staff's motion is reasonable and is not opposed by any party. It will be granted.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Staff is granted leave to refile its Staff Revenue Requirement Cost of Service

Report.
