On February 1, 2006, Kansas City Power & Light Company submitted to the Commission proposed tariff sheets intended to implement a general rate increase for electrical service provided in its Missouri service area. On August 25, Trigen-Kansas city Energy Corporation filed its Motion to Compel Responses to Data Requests and for Expedited Treatment.

The Commission notes that Trigen asks the Commission for an order compelling KCPL to respond to the data requests no later than September 5. Although the Commission likely will not rule on Trigen's application by then, the Commission will order KCPL to file an expedited response.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Kansas City Power & Light Company shall respond to the Motion to Compel Responses to Data Requests and for Expedited Treatment filed by Trigen-Kansas City Energy Corporation no later than September 1, 2006.

2. This order shall become effective on August 28, 2006.
