ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND
TO AGREEMENT ON TRUE-UP

On April 13, 2007, Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE, and the Staff of the Commission filed a joint notice indicating that they have reached an agreement on all true-up issues. AmerenUE and Staff suggest that the true-up hearing, presently scheduled for April 19 and 20, be canceled. They also request that the Commission accept into evidence the true-up direct testimonies and schedules of Gary S. Weiss, Stephen M. Rackers and Greg R. Meyers, as well as AmerenUE's Revised True-Up Accounting Schedules and Staff's Revised True-up Reconciliation. On April 16, Noranda Aluminum, Inc. filed a response indicating that it does not oppose cancellation of the true-up hearing.

Before it acts to cancel the true-up and admit the prefiled true-up testimony, the Commission will allow the other parties an opportunity to respond.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Any party that wishes to respond to the Joint Notification of Agreement on True-Up filed by the Staff of the Commission and Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE, shall do so no later than April 17, 2007.

2. This order shall become effective on April 16, 2007.
