ORDER REQUESTING SCENARIOS

Issue Date: May 15, 2007

Effective Date: May 15, 2007

The Commission will direct its Staff to file a financial scenario describing the effect on AmerenUE's revenue requirement and resulting rates if the Commission issued a report and order incorporating the following positions. In particular, the Commission would like to know the impact the adjusted rates would have on the average residential customer.

1. Fuel Adjustment Clause – No FAC allowed
2. Off System Sales – Base for sales set at \$233 million with a regulatory asset/liability tracker for consideration in the company's next rate case
3. Capital Structure – No adjustment from the capital structure proposed by the company
4. Return on Equity – 10.2%
5. Electric Energy, Inc. – No adjustment for EEInc.
6. Pinckneyville and Kinmundy – No adjustment to the rate base amount requested by the company
7. Peno Creek – No adjustment to the rate base amount requested by the company

8. SO₂ Allowance Sales – Accept the position of Staff
9. Depreciation
 - A. 4 CSR 240-10.020 – No adjustment
 - B. Life Span of Fossil Fuel and Hydro Plants – Accept Staff's position
 - C. Callaway Plant Life Span – Assume a 20 year life extension for Callaway
 - D. Terminal Net Salvage – No terminal net salvage will be allowed
 - E. Historic or Future Inflation Rates – Accept AmerenUE's position
 - F. Should Net Salvage Percents be Based on Actual Net Salvage Expense?
– No
 - G. Difference Between Actual Book Accumulated and Theoretical Accrued Depreciation – No adjustment
 - H. Net Salvage Percentage to be used for Assets in Account 322 – Accept the percentage proposed by Staff and AmerenUE
10. Metro East – Accept AmerenUE's position
11. Taum Sauk Regulatory Capacity – Reject OPC proposal, No adjustment

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Staff of the Commission shall file its response to the above scenario no later than May 17, 2007.
2. Any other party wishing to file a response to the above scenario shall do so no later than May 17, 2007.

3. This order shall become effective on May 15, 2007.
