On October 3, 2007, Kansas City Power & Light Company and the Staff of the Commission filed a Stipulation and Agreement as to Certain Issues. Because other parties did not enter into the stipulation, the stipulation is non-unanimous.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.115(2) governs non-unanimous stipulations. That rule states that parties have seven days to respond to such stipulations. However, Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.015 allows the Commission to waive a rule in Chapter 2 for good cause.

The Commission finds good cause to waive the seven-day rule due to the potential logistic problem of accommodating several parties' schedules for additional hearing dates should any party object to the stipulation. The Commission will shorten the time for parties to respond to the stipulation, thereby permitting the Commission and the parties to proceed with the hearing on the issues contained in the stipulation during the week of October 8-12. The Commission reminds the parties that Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.115 provides that any party that fails to file a timely objection to a non-unanimous stipulation waives its right to a hearing on the issues contained therein, and that the

Commission may treat the stipulation as if it were unanimous if it does not receive a timely filed objection.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. Any party wishing to object to the Stipulation and Agreement as to Certain Issues filed by Kansas City Power & Light Company and the Staff of the Commission shall do so no later than noon, October 9, 2007.
 - 2. This order shall become effective on October 4, 2007.
