On August 13, Staff filed its Motion to Modify Procedural Schedule. Staff asks the Commission to change the schedule to allow all rebuttal testimony to be due on August 30. Staff stated that it has contacted all parties, and that it received responses from all but Ford Motor Company, the Missouri Joint Municipal Electric Utility Commission and the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers group. Staff further states that no party who responded to Staff objects to Staff's request.

The Commission allowed parties until August 17 to respond to Staff's motion. No party responded. Therefore, the Commission will take up Staff's motion unopposed. The Commission finds Staff's motion reasonable, and will grant it.

1. The Motion to Modify Procedural Schedule filed by the Staff of the Commission is granted.
2. All rebuttal testimony shall be filed no later than August 30, 2007.

3. This order shall become effective on August 20, 2007.
