On February 1, 2006, Kansas City Power & Light Company submitted to the Commission proposed tariff sheets intended to implement a general rate increase for electrical service provided in its Missouri service area. The Commission named Missouri Joint Municipal Electric Utility Commission an intervenor by virtue of its participation in KCP&L's experimental regulatory plan case, which was Case No. EO-2005-0329.

On April 4, MJMEUC asked for leave to withdraw from this case. MJMEUC states that it has no position on KCP&L's request for a rate increase.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) allows parties ten days to respond to motions. No parties responded to MJMEUC's motion. Therefore, the Commission will take the motion up unopposed.

The Commission finds MJMEUC's request reasonable, and will grant it.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Motion of Missouri Joint Municipal Electricity Utility Commission for

Leave to Withdraw from Proceeding is granted.
