ORDER CLARIFYING ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR NECESSARY
WAIVERS, DENYING PENDING MOTIONS, AND DIRECTING FILING

Effective Date: November 20, 2006

This order clarifies that direct testimony by all parties, except Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE, related to AmerenUE's tariff pages designed to implement a fuel adjustment clause (FAC) and denominated as Rider A-Fuel and Purchased Power Adjustment Clause shall be filed on or before December 29, 2006.

On November 2, 2006, the Commission issued its Order Granting Motion for Necessary Waivers, Denying Pending Motions, and Directing Filing. In that order, at page 4, the Commission stated that direct testimony by all parties, aside from AmerenUE, was due on December 30, 2006. The reference to the 30th was a typographical error. The date should have read December 29, 2006.

The procedural schedule in this case contains two dates when specific portions of direct testimony from all parties, aside from AmerenUE, are to be filed. The Commission intended for direct testimony pertaining to AmerenUE's FAC filing to be filed by all parties, aside from AmerenUE, with the direct testimony on customer class cost of service and rate design on or before December 29, 2006.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Direct testimony by all parties, aside from Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE, related to the tariff sheets denominated as Rider A–Fuel and Purchased Power Adjustment Clause submitted in this case by Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE on September 29, 2006, will be due on or before December 29, 2006.
2. This order shall become effective on November 20, 2006.
