28	for this case.	The testing was completed on May 28, 2007, prior to the conclusion of the true-

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up period (September 30, 2007) for this case. Staff is not aware of any issues that would prevent the costs of the SCR from being included in rate base for rate-making treatment.

- Q. What is your conclusion regarding in-service criteria for the La Cygne Unit 1 SCR?
- A. Based on my review and analysis of the data and inspection of the facilities, the La Cygne Unit 1 SCR should be considered fully operational and used for service.
