ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO MODIFY PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On November 2, the Office of the Public Counsel filed its Motion to Reschedule True-Up Hearing. OPC points out that both it and Staff are scheduled for oral argument in front of The Circuit Court of Cole County on November 8, and are therefore unavailable for the true-up hearing currently set for November 8. OPC asks the Commission to move the hearing to November 9. OPC asserts that Staff has inquired of the parties whether anyone objects to a November 9 true-up hearing, and has heard no objection.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) allows parties ten days to respond to motions. However, because the true-up hearing is due to begin later this week, and because no party objects to OPC's motion, the Commission will waive the ten-day rule, and take up OPC's motion unopposed.

The Commission finds the motion reasonable, and will grant it.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Public Counsel's Motion to Reschedule True-Up Hearing is granted.
2. The true-up hearing will be held on November 9, 2007, beginning at 8:30 a.m., at the Commission's offices in the Governor Office Building, Room 310,

200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri, a facility that meets the accessibility standards of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). 3. This order shall become effective on November 5, 2007.
