MISSOURI'S MOTION TO FILE SUPPLEMENTAL SURREBUTTAL

On March 2, 2007, the State of Missouri filed a motion requesting leave to file the supplemental surrebuttal testimony of Michael Brosch regarding the income-tax-expenses-cost-of-removal-normalization issue. A copy of Brosch's testimony was filed along with the motion. Under the Commission's rules of procedure,¹ other parties would be allowed ten days in which to respond to the State of Missouri's motion. However, given the short time remaining before the commencement of the hearing, the Commission will shorten the time allowed to respond to that motion.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Any party wishing to respond to the State of Missouri's Motion to File the Supplemental Surrebuttal Testimony of Michael Brosch shall do so no later than March 6, 2007.
