**ORDER GRANTING LEAVE**  
**TO APPEAR *PRO HAC VICE***

This order grants the petition for leave to appear *pro hac vice* of Paul N. Jones on behalf of the United States Department of Energy/National Nuclear Security Administration.

On March 15, 2007 Mr. Jones filed a petition for leave to appear *pro hac vice*. His petition states that he is licensed to practice law in Texas, New Mexico, Massachusetts, Mississippi, and the District of Columbia. He also appoints Mark Comley, a member of the Missouri Bar appearing in this case, as local counsel. And, finally, he provided proof of compliance with Missouri Supreme Court Rule 6.01(m).

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) allows parties ten days to respond to motions. No parties timely responded. Therefore, the Commission will take up the application unopposed.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.040(3)(C) lists the standard for appearing before the Commission *pro hac vice*. The Commission finds that Mr. Jones has complied with that rule and with Missouri Supreme Court Rule 6.01(m). Therefore, the Commission will grant the petition.

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. The Petition for Leave to Appear *Pro Hac Vice* of Paul N. Jones is granted.
2. This order shall become effective on April 4, 2007.
