NOTICE OF DISMISSAL

Issue Date: October 28, 2013

On August 12, 2013, Summit Natural Gas of Missouri, Inc. ("SNG") filed an *Application and Motion for Waiver*, requesting an accounting authority order that would allow SNG to undertake certain accounting procedures in connection with a change in the assessment methodology for the calculation of property taxes. On October 25, 2013, SNG filed a *Notice of Voluntary Dismissal*, stating that SNG has decided to voluntarily dismiss its application without prejudice.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.116(1) states that an applicant may dismiss an application without an order of the Commission before prepared testimony or oral evidence has been offered. The parties have not offered prepared testimony or oral evidence. The Commission, therefore, will take notice of SNG's dismissal. This case shall be closed.
