## LIST OF REMAINING ISSUES

SBC Missouri<sup>1</sup> and the Joint Sponsors,<sup>2</sup> pursuant to the Missouri Public Service Commission's February 4, 2003 <u>Order Establishing Further Procedural Schedule</u>, respectfully submit the following report on the progress of negotiations and a list of the remaining substantive issues:

- 1. As the parties indicated in their January 30, 2003 Second Joint Status Report, SBC Missouri and the Joint Sponsors, through diligent and good faith efforts, successfully narrowed the list of approximately 30 outstanding issues to only 12.
- 2. Additional discussions between SBC Missouri and the Joint Sponsors have resulted in the resolution of several more issues, so that now only four remain (Issues 158, 198, 317 and 353).
- 3. SBC Missouri and the Joint Sponsor parties represent that their mutual resolution of the Joint Sponsors' issues concerning SBC Missouri's compliance cost studies have been resolved in the nature of a settlement limited to this particular case, where neither party concedes its position or is otherwise prejudiced from asserting its position in another proceeding. The

parties' resolution of these issues is contingent on the resolutions being accepted strictly as settlements to avoid further litigation and not reflective of any substantive positions. The parties expressly reserve the right to assert their respective substantive positions in future proceedings.

4. SBC Missouri and the Joint Sponsors plan to present the following four issues to the Commission for resolution in accordance with the approved briefing schedule:

<u>Issue 158</u>. Should multiplexing equipment be included in the recurring cost for the cross-connects in this study?

<u>Remaining Issue for Resolution</u>: Is it appropriate under the Commission's Order to include costs for the FXO plug in card in the study for the 2 and 4 wire cross-connects?

<u>Issue 198</u>. Dispatch time to unmanned central offices, and order completion.

Remaining Issue for Resolution: Has SBC Missouri used the correct dispatch time as ordered by the Commission for provisioning entrance facilities for DS1, DS3, OC3, and OC12 unbundled dedicated transport?

Issue 317. Probability of occurrence for verifying a feature.

<u>Remaining Issue for Resolution</u>: Has SBC Missouri correctly applied the 2% fallout rate from the Commission's Order?

<u>Issue 353</u>. White pages activities.

Remaining Issue for Resolution: Has SBC Missouri removed the "time for coordination with white pages personnel" as directed by the Commission's Order?
