ORDER GRANTING STAFF'S MOTION FOR ADDITIONAL TIME TO FILE A PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On February 1, 2007, Kansas City Power & Light Company submitted to the Commission proposed tariff sheets intended to implement a general rate increase for electrical service provided in its Missouri service area. The Commission held a prehearing conference on March 14, and required the parties to file a proposed procedural schedule no later than March 21.

On March 21, the Staff of the Commission filed a Motion for Additional Time to File a Proposed Procedural Schedule. Staff explains that, due to the press of business of the AmerenUE rate case hearing, Staff has been unable to receive feedback from other parties on their schedule preferences. As such, Staff asks the Commission for additional time to file a proposed procedural schedule.

The Commission finds Staff's motion reasonable, and will grant it.

 The Motion for Additional Time to File a Proposed Procedural Schedule time filed by the Staff of the Commission is granted.
