**ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND TO APPLICATIONS FOR
REHEARING AND MOTION FOR STAY, AND DIRECTING STAFF TO
FILE RECOMMENDATION REGARDING TARIFF**

On February 5, 2009, Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE, Noranda Aluminum, Inc., AARP, and the Office of the Public Counsel filed Applications for Rehearing regarding the Commission's Report and Order. Noranda also filed a motion asking the Commission to stay the effect of its Report and Order. AmerenUE asks the Commission to expedite its consideration of its Application for Rehearing, and Noranda seeks expedited consideration of its motion seeking a stay.

Before acting on these matters, the Commission will establish a time for the parties to file responses to the applications for rehearing. In addition, the Commission will direct Staff to file a recommendation regarding the compliance tariff AmerenUE filed on January 30, 2009

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any party wishing to respond to any application for rehearing filed by any other party shall do so no later than February 10, 2009.
2. Any party wishing to respond to Noranda Aluminum, Inc.'s Motion for Stay shall do so no later than February 10, 2009.

3. No later than February 10, 2009, Staff shall file its recommendation regarding AmerenUE's compliance tariff, filed on January 30, 2009.

4. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
