NOTICE OF SUPPORT FOR SPIRE’S PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, through the undersigned counsel, and for its *Notice of Support for Spire’s Procedural Schedule* states:

1. On March 26, 2021 Symmetry filed a complaint against Spire relating to Operational Flow Order (OFO) penalties Spire assessed following February’s cold weather event.
2. On May 27, 2021 the Commission ordered the parties to jointly file a proposed procedural schedule by June 10, 2021.
3. Despite discussion between the parties, an agreement was not reached regarding this proposed procedural schedule.
4. In lieu of a joint proposed procedural schedule, Symmetry and Spire each filed its own proposed procedural schedule on June 10, 2021.
5. Staff supports Spire’s proposed schedule.
