**RESPONSE OF UNION ELECTRIC COMPANY d/b/a AMEREN MISSOURI  
TO PUBLIC COUNSEL'S REPLY**

In its May 24, 2011, "Reply to the Response of Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri in Opposition to Motion to Compel," the Office of the Public Counsel ("OPC") asserts that Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri's ("Ameren Missouri") previously-filed response in opposition to OPC's motion to compel failed to acknowledge that the Commission's Order Adopting Procedural Schedule, Establishing Test Year, and Delegating Authority in this case specifically provides that the requirements of 4 CSR 240-2.090(8)(A) have been waived. OPC's assertion is completely accurate; consequently, all references and arguments regarding that rule that are contained in Ameren Missouri's response are in error and should be disregarded.
