## ORDER INDEFINITELY STAYING FILING DEADLINES

Issue Date: August 16, 2011 Effective Date: August 16, 2011

Halo Wireless, Inc. has filed suggestions in bankruptcy in all three of these actions. Deadlines were previously set requiring various party responses to pleadings, and a deadline of September 12, 2011 is set for parties to file a legal analysis as to whether these actions may proceed before the Commission or if these actions are automatically stayed pursuant to the Bankruptcy Code as is alleged by Halo.

On August 16, 2011, Alma Communications, et al. filed a motion in File Number IC-2011-0385 requesting that all current response deadlines, except for the September

11

12, 2011 deadline, be stayed indefinitely until it can be determined if the bankruptcy code's automatic stay of commencement or "continuation" of certain proceedings applies to these actions. BPS Telephone, et al. filed a similar motion in File Number TC-2011-0404. The Commission finds the requests to be reasonable and will grant them. Because all three captioned matters could be affected by the bankruptcy action, the Commission will stay any filing or procedural deadlines in all three matters.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. All procedural and filing deadlines currently set in these matters, with the exception of the September 12, 2011 deadline for filing a legal analysis of Halo Wireless, Inc.'s suggestions of bankruptcy, are indefinitely stayed.
  - 2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
