NOTICE ACKNOWLEDGING VOLUNTARY DISMISSAL OF COMPLAINT
AND CLOSING CASE

Issue Date: April 24, 2007

William Rapp filed a formal complaint against Laclede Gas Company ("Laclede") on October 24, 2006. On April 23, 2007, prior to the filing of any prepared testimony or the submission of any oral evidence, Mr. Rapp and Laclede filed a Joint Notice of Dismissal ("Joint Notice"), in which they informed the Commission that they had resolved all disputes covered by the complaint¹ and that all parties of record had been served with a copy of the Joint Notice.

Accordingly, the parties requested that the Commission acknowledge the Joint Notice and close the case pursuant to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.116(1), which permits a complainant to voluntarily dismiss his complaint without an order of the

Commission “at any time before prepared testimony has been filed or oral evidence has been offered, by filing a notice of dismissal with the commission and serving a copy on all parties.”

No prepared testimony or oral evidence has been offered in this case, and the Joint Notice has been filed with the Commission and served on all parties. Therefore, the Commission acknowledges that William Rapp has voluntarily dismissed his complaint against Laclede Gas Company. Nothing remains for decision by the Commission and this case may be closed.
