ORDER DIRECTING FILING

The Commission held an evidentiary hearing in this matter from October 16-27. During the hearing, the parties announced that they had settled certain issues, and that stipulations would be filed. Therefore, the Commission ordered its Staff to file those stipulations or, in the alternative, a status report that lists what issues have settled among what parties, and that indicates when the Commission can expect filed stipulations.

On November 8, Staff replied stating that the Commission could expect a stipulation on Class Cost of Service and Rate design on November 9. Indeed, Staff filed that stipulation timely.

Also, Staff mentioned that the Commission could expect a stipulation on pensions no later than November 14, and a stipulation on Regulatory Plan Additional Amortizations no later than November 17. The Commission has not received those stipulations. The Commission will order its Staff to file the above-referenced stipulations on pensions, Regulatory Plan Additional Amortizations, and all other settled issues.

Also, the Commission notes that during the true-up hearing held on November 16, Staff witness Steve Traxler mentioned that he was working with KCPL and

the Office of the Public Counsel on a True-Up Reconciliation. The Commission will order its Staff to file that True-Up Reconciliation as well.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Staff of the Commission shall file pleadings as described above no later than noon, December 4, 2006.
2. This order shall become effective on November 29, 2006.
