The Missouri Public Service Commission is granting the Motion for Extension of

*Time to File Staff Recommendation* that Staff filed on August 23, 2010.<sup>1</sup> Staff asks the

Commission to extend the date for filing Staff's recommendation to August 31, 2010.

The Commission's regulations provide:

When an act is required or allowed to be done by order or rule of the commission at or within a specified time, the commission, at its discretion, may—

(A) Order the period enlarged before the expiration of the period originally prescribed  $[.^2]$ 

That regulation sets forth no standard to guide the exercise of the Commission's discretion, but Staff argues that such extension will allow a more complete recommendation. That reason constitutes good cause to grant the motion.

#### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Motion for Extension of Time to File Staff Recommendation is granted.

2. Staff shall file its recommendation on the application no later than August 31, 2010.
