MOTION TO COMPEL AND MOTION FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT

Under authority of, and in accordance with, 4 CSR 240-2.080 and 4 CSR 240-2.090, and for good cause shown, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri ("Ameren Missouri" or "the Company"), through its undersigned attorneys, hereby moves the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") for an order compelling Earth Island Institute d/b/a Renew Missouri ("Renew Missouri") to fully and completely respond to Ameren Missouri data requests DR-004 through DR-006, which the Company served on Renew Missouri on March 17, 2014. In addition, because obtaining the information sought in the data requests at issue in this motion is crucial to Ameren Missouri being able to prepare for and participate in a hearing scheduled for Friday, April 4, 2014, the Company further moves for expedited consideration of its motion to compel.

In support of its motions, Ameren Missouri states:

- 1. The procedural schedule adopted by the Commission through its order dated February 26, 2014, was agreed to by all parties, including Renew Missouri. Paragraph 7 of that schedule states that to accommodate the schedule on an expedited basis "the Parties agree to shorten the response time pursuant to Rule 4 CSR 240-2.090 for all data requests to five (5) business days to respond and three (3) business days to object."
- 2. In accordance with the prescribed schedule and agreement, Ameren Missouri served Henry Robertson, counsel of record for Renew Missouri, with data requests DR-004 through DR-006 on March

17, 2014. Copies of those data requests are attached to these motions as Exhibit A, and are incorporated by reference.

- 3. Although objections to the data requests were due by March 20, 2014, and answers by March 24, 2014, Ameren Missouri received no response of any kind to the data requests at issue in this motion by the prescribed deadlines. Renew Missouri finally responded on March 27, 2014, and although the deadline for lodging objections has passed, Renew Missouri objected to each of the data requests at issue in this motion. Copies of Renew Missouri's responses containing its objections are attached to these motions as Exhibit B, and are incorporated by reference.
- 4. Renew Missouri's failure to timely object to the data requests at issue here constitutes a waiver of any objections made on March 27, 2014. Consequently, those objections, which were filed seven calendar days and five business days beyond the deadline for objections specified in the procedural order, should be disregarded and Renew Missouri should be required to fully respond to each of the data requests at issue. As the Commission noted in a recent case that involved objections filed out of time, "as a general rule, a party that does not timely object to a discovery request has waived its objection." *Mark v. Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P.*, Case No. TC-2006-0354, 2006 Mo. PSC LEXIS 1368 (October 12, 2006).
- 5. Putting aside the issue of waiver, Renew Missouri's objections to the data requests at issue are not valid and would not withstand scrutiny even if they had been timely filed. The grounds for Renew Missouri's objections to all three data requests are stated in the response to DR-004. In summary, those grounds are: (i) the Company failed to establish the relevance of the requested information, and (ii) the information requested involves communications with a person who is not a party to the current case. Neither of these stated grounds for Renew Missouri's objections is valid.
- 6. A cursory reading of each of the data requests at issue reveals that they were carefully and purposely written to seek information that is relevant or is designed to lead to the discovery of such

¹ Although Renew Missouri's response to DR-005 includes an untimely objection, the response also states that Renew Missouri does not have any documents responsive to the request. Consequently, despite the untimely objection, Renew Missouri may not have any additional information to provide in response to DR-005.

information – to this case. Indeed, it is difficult to conceive how these data requests could have been worded to more narrowly focus the scope of the Company's inquiries. For example, the requests in DR-004 are specifically limited to information regarding conversations or correspondence between Renew Missouri and Charles Skoda "regarding any issue in Case No. EA-2014-0136." A similar limitation applies to DR-004. That request seeks copies of documents that relate to each communication identified in the response to DR-004, which, as noted in the preceding sentence, is limited to communications regarding issues in the current case. Finally, DR-006 seeks information regarding "any and all forms of support, including but not limited to financial support" that Renew Missouri is receiving from Mr. Skoda, Noranda Aluminum, Inc., the Missouri Industrial Energy Users Association, or other affiliated groups or organizations. But, again, the scope of the request is limited to support provided "in connection with Renew Missouri's intervention and participation in Case No. EA-2014-0136."

- 7. Renew Missouri's alternate ground for its objections that persons who are not parties to this case are incapable of providing information that satisfies the relevance standard applicable to discovery is completely without merit. It is axiomatic that non-parties have and can provide information that is itself relevant or that will lead to the discovery of such information. In fact, one need look no farther than the roster of prospective witnesses in this case to see that Renew Missouri, itself, rejects the notion that non-parties cannot provide relevant information. Neither Martin Cohen, who prefiled rebuttal testimony on Renew Missouri's behalf, nor Martin Roth Cohen and Associates is a party to this case. Yet by sponsoring Mr. Cohen's testimony, Renew Missouri has implicitly expressed its belief a non-party has information to offer the Commission that is relevant to the issues in this case.
- 8. As noted previously, the evidentiary hearing in this case is scheduled for Friday, April 4, 2014; consequently, the interval between the filing date of this motion and the date of that hearing is extremely brief. Moreover, because the discovery conference, which the Commission's rules require as prerequisite to a motion to compel, was completed just a few hours before these motions are being filed, the need to expedite the consideration of Ameren Missouri's motion was caused by neglect or by the Company's failure to timely press its claim for the discovery responses to which it is entitled. Good cause

therefore exists for the Commission to expedite its consideration and decision of Ameren Missouri's motion to compel. Accordingly, the Company requests the Commission to (i) require Renew Missouri to respond to these motions no later than 5:00 p.m., CDT, on Tuesday, April 1, 2014, and (ii) render a decision on the motions no later than 12:00 p.m., CDT, on Wednesday, April 2, 2014. If the Commission grants Ameren Missouri's motion, the order should require Renew Missouri to fully respond to each of the data requests no later than 12:00 p.m., CDT, on Thursday, April 3, 2014, and should caution Renew Missouri that failure to provide the required responses could result in Renew Missouri being denied the right to present evidence at, and otherwise participate in, the April 4th evidentiary hearing.

WHEREFORE, for all the reasons stated above, Ameren Missouri asks the Commission to grant the Company's motion to compel and motion for expedited treatment, to issue an order requiring Renew Missouri to provide full and complete responses to data requests DR-004 through DR-006 in accordance with the schedule and subject to the conditions described in the preceding paragraph, and to further grant the Company such other relief as the Commission deems appropriate.
