MOTION FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT OF TARIFF

COMES NOW KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company ("GMO" or the "Company") and, pursuant to the terms of 4 CSR 240-2.080(14), hereby submits its motion for expedited treatment of GMO's 1st Revised Tariff Sheet No. 137.3.

1. In April 2014, the Company filed an application in Case No. EO-2014-0151 requesting authorization to implement a Renewable Energy Standard Rate Adjustment Mechanism ("RESRAM") to recover expenditures to comply with the Renewable Energy Standard ("RES") law, Section 393.1030, RSMo.

2. On November 5, 2014, the Commission issued its Order approving the *Partial Stipulation and Agreement, Rejecting Tariff, and Establishing Procedural Schedule* with an effective date of November 15, 2014. The RESRAM was implemented and the rate was applied to customers' bills beginning December 1, 2014.¹

3. GMO's Tariff Sheet No. 137.2 states: "The Company shall make a RESRAM filing during each calendar year. Each filing shall become effective in December of each year and such Rider RESRAM filings shall be made at least sixty (60) days prior to their effective dates."

4. The Company inadvertently missed its "sixty (60) days prior" filing date for the new tariff.

5. There will be no detriment to customers if the Commission processes this tariff on an expedited basis and makes the tariff effective December 1, 2015. GMO's retail customer revenues, as determined in the 2012 rate case, have not changed since December 1, 2014 and GMO's current annual RESRAM revenue requirement would exceed the current RESRAM cost recovery cap applicable to GMO. Therefore the allowable annual revenue requirement and the current RESRAM rate remains unchanged.

6. Missouri Public Service Commission Staff has been apprised of the proposed tariff.

7. The Company has filed this Motion for Expedited Treatment as soon as it could reasonably have done so under the circumstances.

WHEREFORE, GMO requests the Commission great expedited treatment of GMO's 1st evised Tariff Sheet No. 137.3 to become effective December 1, 2015.
