STATUS REPORT

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, by and through counsel, and for its *Status Report* states as follows:

1. Staff has reviewed Ameren Missouri's Application filed November 19th and its Amended Application filed November 24th.
2. Staff provided a copy of Ameren Missouri's Application to the Pipeline Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) because of the involvement of federal pipeline regulations and related state rules. PHMSA has requested a copy of Staff's proposed waiver conditions.
3. Staff issued initial data requests to Ameren Missouri on November 24th.
4. Staff is currently analyzing Ameren Missouri's Application and responses to its data requests.
5. Staff will complete a draft recommendation and provide it to PHMSA for review of proposed waiver conditions. When Staff receives PHMSA's input, Staff will finalize its recommendation and file it with the Commission.
6. Staff anticipates filing its recommendation no later than December 21st but will file it earlier if possible, depending on the outcome of its coordination with PHMSA.

WHEREFORE, Staff prays the Commission accept its *Status Report* and allow it to file its recommendation, or a status report, no later than December 21, 2020.
