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- JUDGE VOSS: Good morning, we're here for
- 3 the pre-hearing conference in Commission Case No.
- 4 GC-2007-0451 in the matter of Doris House versus
- 5 Laclede Gas Company. I'm Cherlyn Voss, I'm the
- 6 Regulatory Law Judge assigned to hear this case.
- 7 And we're going to begin by taking entries of
- 8 appearance.
- 9 When the company gives their address, you can
- 10 choose to give counsel's entry or enter your address,
- 11 whichever you are more comfortable with.
- 12 Beginning with you, Mr. Zucker.
- MR. ZUCKER: Rick Zucker, Z-U-C-K-E-R, here
- 14 on behalf of Laclede Gas Company, 720 Olive Street,
- 15 St. Louis, Missouri 63101.
- 16 MR. ROBINSON: James Robinson on behalf of
- 17 Doris House. I've given my business address to all
- 18 parties, including the court stenographer, and I'm
- 19 here on behalf of Doris House. Her resident address
- 20 is 5928 A Julian, 63112.
- 21 JUDGE VOSS: And let the record show that
- 22 it is 10:07, and neither counsel for the Staff or
- 23 Office of the Public Counsel are present.
- 24 The primary purpose of this pre-hearing is to
- 25 bring the parties together to discuss the

- 1 possibilities for settlement, or to schedule a
- 2 hearing, or any other evidentiary procedures that need
- 3 to be addressed.
- We do occasionally do testimony, a lot of times
- 5 there is not a need for pre-file testimony live at
- 6 hearing, whatever you are more comfortable with. And
- 7 if you have any questions about what pre-file
- 8 testimony entails, I will leave here and hunt down a
- 9 Staff attorney, he may be able to answer those
- 10 questions.
- 11 If there aren't any additional matters that you
- 12 need me to discuss on the record, we'll go off the
- 13 record and let you guys conduct settlement or
- 14 procedural issues. If you need me for anything, I'm
- 15 at 751-3966 upstairs.
- MR. ZUCKER: Thank you, Judge.
- JUDGE VOSS: And I'm Cherlyn Voss.
- 18 MR. ROBINSON: I'd like to state on the
- 19 record; Miss House has some additional information,
- 20 which I think is pertinent in that it wasn't in the
- 21 initial complaint. However, everyone has to mitigate
- 22 their circumstances in some kind of manner, and
- 23 attempting to mitigate after --
- JUDGE VOSS: This is not a place to take
- 25 evidence. I'm not allowed to take evidence. But

- 1 something you can talk about --
- 2 MR. ROBINSON: But I think it's relevant to
- 3 the fact that Miss House has discovered a leak.
- 4 JUDGE VOSS: I feel pretty comfortable with
- 5 this because Laclede is on the phone, but this isn't
- 6 really the opportunity to take evidence. You can file
- 7 an amended complaint if you like, or if we go to a
- 8 hearing you can admit that evidence. But I would
- 9 really suggest that you cover the basics and file an
- 10 amended complaint with that information.
- 11 MR. ROBINSON: We didn't have time, because
- 12 we discovered it --
- MS. HOUSE: Recently.
- MR. ROBINSON: -- in the last couple days.
- JUDGE VOSS: That is something you can --
- 16 off the record -- discuss with Mr. Zucker. And then,
- 17 again, whatever you guys bring to this, if you need to
- 18 file an amended complaint, or you may agree to a
- 19 certain amount of time they have to respond to it,
- 20 like 30 days, to keep this ball rolling. Or
- 21 Mr. Zucker might see something in new evidence that
- 22 would persuade him to settle. Whatever you decide to
- 23 take care of, but I'm not allowed to hear ex parte.
- 24 This concludes the on-the-record portion of this
- 25 pre-hearing conference. I'll be here if you need me

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for anything else. I'm going to find Staff counsel
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     and get a copy of our current hearing schedule if you
     need to look at the dates.
