**ORDER CANCELING EVIDENTIARY HEARING
AND EXTENDING TIME TO RESPOND TO COMPLAINT**

On November 3, 2015, the counsel for Commerce Tower Group, LLC notified the regulatory law judge that the parties are actively seeking to resolve the issues raised in the complaint and request that the evidentiary hearing be rescheduled. Staff supports continuing the settlement discussions and rescheduling the hearing. The Commission will cancel the evidentiary hearing scheduled for November 6, 2015. If the settlement discussions are no longer productive, the parties may request that the evidentiary hearing be rescheduled.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The evidentiary hearing scheduled for November 6, 2015, is canceled.
2. The deadline for Veolia Energy Kansas City, Inc. to file its answer to the complaint or a request for mediation is extended until no later than November 19, 2015.
