On September 18, 2008,¹ the Commission issued its Order Approving Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement and Authorizing Tariff Filing ("Order") in this matter bearing an effective date of September 26. In that order, the Commission directed Trigen-Kansas City Energy Corporation ("Trigen") to file tariffs in compliance with the approved Stipulation and Agreement unanimously agreed to by the parties to this action. On September 26, in its attempt to comply with the Commission's Order, Trigen submitted said tariffs and assigned Tariff Tracking Nos. YH-2008-0224 and YH-2008-0225, each bearing an effective date of November 1. Consequently, the Commission directs its Staff to review Trigen's tariff filings and file a report and recommendation as to whether Trigen is now in compliance with the Commission's Order.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. No later than October 15, 2008, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file a report and recommendation regarding Trigen-Kansas City Energy Corporation's compliance tariff filings stating whether Trigen-Kansas City Energy
